The Calgary Police Service is seeking the public's assistance in apprehending the culprit responsible for numerous house break and enters that occurred between Friday, January 26 and Saturday, January 27 in the communities of Albert Park Radisson Heights, Forest Heights and Forest Lawn. Entry to the residences was gained through unlocked doors and windows and by forcing/prying doors. Once inside, electronics and a purse were taken.

The suspect is described as an Aboriginal male, approximately 20-25 years old, 5'8" with black hair (shaved on the sides and longer on top). A light brown truck may be associated to the suspect.

The Calgary Police Service would like to remind residents to always lock their doors and secure windows, even while they are at home. This includes locking deadbolts on doors and installing security bars on basement windows. Do not leave window or door screens exposed, especially at night. Ensure electronics and tools can be identified by noting the serial number, model and brand or with identifiable markings or engraving.
