

This is the Calgary Police Service with a PACT Message for  
Parkhill, Erlton, Rideau Park, Roxboro and Elboya.

On March 6, 2007, three male suspects made contact with a 16 year old female walking alone at approximately 1630 hours in the Parkhill area. The males persuaded the female to get into their car, at which time they drove a short distance and made sexual advances towards the girl. The female demanded to be let free and was released in the immediate area.

All three suspects are described as black males, approximately 5'11"- 6'2", 18-25 years of age. The vehicle is described as a silver, four door sedan, with the possible make of Honda or Toyota.

Police are reminding parents and students to be diligent with regards to suspicious persons and vehicles. For safety, it is recommended that students travel in groups and that parents escort their children to and from school.
