

THIS IS THE CALGARY POLICE SERVICE WITH A P.A.C.T. MESSAGE FOR: ACADIA.

The Calgary Police Service is seeking the public's assistance in apprehending the culprits(s) responsible for 4 daytime house break ins that occurred in Acadia area between April 5th and April 11th. Entry was gained either by breaking a basement window or prying a rear door. Once inside, jewelry and electronics were taken.

Residents need to be aware that the number of house break ins in the month of April appears unusually high as to previous months.

The Calgary Police Service would like to remind residents to always lock their doors and secure windows, even while they are at home. This includes locking deadbolts on doors and installing security bars on basement windows. Do not leave window or door screens exposed, especially at night. Ensure electronics and tools can be identified by noting the serial number, model and brand or with identifiable markings or engraving.
